Rules of the competition:

1. The photo must signify the theme "On the farm".
2. The photographer must provide a caption for the photo.
3. Photos that are sent in should be unique and should not represent the same theme as photos that are entered for other photo competitions. Photos entered for this competition may also not have been published previously.
4. Photos may not be digitally manipulated; this means that one can not make changes to the photo afterwards. For example: removing an awkward tree digitally, or adding a beautiful flower to the background or move elements on the photo closer to each other. You may, however, crop the picture to remove unwanted parts at the top, bottom or on the sides. Do not make changes to the contrast.
5. Entries are free and you may enter more than one photo for this competition. Only one photo per email.
6. Photographers can send in their photos up until the cut-off time every month for that month's competition – entries that are received after the cut-off time will be entered for the following month's competition.
7. Only email entries or photos supplied on CD will be accepted. The photos must be in electronic format: not bigger than 3 MB; in JPG format and not smaller than 10 cm x 15 cm. If photos are taken with a film type camera, it must be scanned at a resolution of 300 dpi.
8. Photos taken with cellphones will not be accepted.
9. Every month a panel consisting of a professional photographer, a representative of SA *Graan/Grain* and a representative of Sasol Nitro will evaluate the photos.
10. SA *Graan/Grain* preserves the right to reject photos that are unclear or that do not comply with the rules of the competition.
11. All entries become the property of SA *Graan/Grain* – this includes the CDs on which the photos are supplied. The photos will be kept in a data bank and SA *Graan/Grain* and Sasol Nitro may use it for future promotional, marketing and publication purposes. By entering this competition, the participant agrees to this and no claims from third parties for violation of copyright may be submitted.
