## **Taxonomy and History**

- Spodoptera genus
  - 31 species in total
- S. frugiperda native to the Americas
  - Eight species in Africa
  - First Discovered in Nigeria, Benin, and Togo



#### **Host Range**

- Over 80 plant species
  - Primary (main), Secondary and Wild hosts





## **Economic Importance**


- Brazil: over US\$400 million
- Zambia
  - US\$ 3 million
  - 130 000 ha of crops
  - Losses of up to 73%







# Life Cycle of FAW between 24 & 40 days!



#### Female



- Wingspan: 3.8 cm
- Body length: 1.7 cm
- Forewings: Mottled (dark brown, grey)
- Hindwings: Silver white with narrow, dark brown margins

#### ■ Male



- Wingspan: 3.7 cm
- Body length: 1.6 cm
- Forewings: Grey and brown (triangular white spots tips)
- Hindwings: Similar to females
