

GRAIN SA SHINES AT THE SA AGRICULTURAL WRITERS AWARDS


» Grain SA was well represented at this year's Agricultural Writers SA's national awards for the Farmer of the Year, New Entrant into Commercial Agriculture and Agriculturalist of the Year for 2016.

Jannie de Villiers was announced as the Gauteng Agriculturist of the Year, together with fellow finalists Dr Gerhard Verdoorn (Eastern Cape), Dr Mias van der Westhuizen (Free State), Barry Christie (Mpumalanga), Hannes Hattingh (Northern Cape), Prof Flippie Cloete (North West), and Andre Roux (Western Cape). Dr Theo de Jager from Limpopo was ultimately awarded the Agriculturist of the Year accolade.




