The partnership represents a commitment to empowering cattle farmers with the financial expertise and resources necessary to create enduring wealth and establish lasting legacies.












Jacobus le Roux Smart Breeding with BKB

EPISODE 03:

John & Tracey Devonport Growing a Cattle Enterprise











- » Commencing their farming operation in 1988 near the Vaal Dam, John and Tracey have expanded their Devlan Limousin stud across seven farms, managing 700 animals and 100 Droughtmaster cattle.
- They specialise in Limousin breeds, recognised for their exceptional meat production efficiency.
- Despite industry challenges including rising operational costs and market competition, they advocate for improved genetics, implementation of conformation scoring systems, and enhanced collaboration across the agricultural supply chain to achieve sustainable industry growth.







EPISODE 04:

Lizette Vermaak South Africa's Premier Livestock Competition





» The Old Mutual Inter-Breed Championships represents South Africa's most prestigious livestock competition, often termed the "World Cup of Shows."



This annual event identifies the nation's finest cattle through rigorous selection criteria qualifying animals must achieve supreme champion status at one of approximately ten designated agricultural shows.



Independent judging panels evaluate entries based on breed-specific excellence and genetic quality.



The competition celebrates the dedication and expertise of South African farmers whilst showcasing exceptional livestock genetics.

PJ Budler International Livestock Expertise





» PJ Budler, a fifth-generation cattle farmer, has developed extensive international experience across Scotland and Texas, founding a global livestock initiative.



» His approach emphasises region-specific management strategies rather than standardised programmes.



» Budler identifies South Africa's competitive advantages: adaptable cattle genetics, economic innovation drivers, minimal government interference, and skilled labour resources.



He advocates for livestock export programmes to prevent market manipulation and promote South African genetics throughout sub-Saharan Africa, positioning the country as a regional agricultural leader.
