#### **Objective of the project – this is the extent of our "dream"**


- To donate flour for 1 million meals per month.

#### Who is involved?


South African grain producers are taking the lead.

Donating roll players in the food value chain supporting Grain Care's grain producers initiative are:


- Financial Institutions;

- Any grain can be donated for the project white and yellow maize, sunflower, sorghum, soy, wheat and barley.




