The incumbent's duties will include, but is not limited to, the following key performance areas.

Marketing: Marketing of Grain SA within the regions allocated to the Marketer. Explaining the purpose of Grain SA as organisation to farmers.

Liaison with other departments within Grain SA: Internal liaison and intermediary function between producers and other departments within Grain SA.

Ad Hoc duties such as the arrangement of regional meetings before Congress, assistance at NAMPO, etc.

Requirements for the Post:

- Experience in commission based marketing will be a strong advantage
- A minimum of 3 years relevant marketing experience
- Sound knowledge of the agricultural sector (preferably grains and oilseeds)
