Maize Market commentary

The CBOT maize price traded 0.13% lower than yesterday and will open today at \$4.51/bushel. Maize exports resulted 993 140 tons in combined old and new crop sales last week. Old crop sales were down 24% week-over-week but remained 14% above the prior four-week average. Total sales were toward the lower end of analyst estimates, which ranged between 723 900 and 1.45 million tons. Maize export shipments eased 7% below the prior four-week average, with 932 180 tons. Mexico, Japan, China, Colombia, and

Panama were the top five destinations. Local: The local market experienced an increasing trading day. The WMAZ cash market traded 1.8% higher opening the day on R4 153/ton, the YMAZ cash price traded 0.5% higher opening the day on R3 784/ton. The Jul'24 WMAZ contract increased by 3.6% opening the day on R3 954/ton while the YMAZ Jul'24 contract increased by 1.9% opening the day on R3 782/ton.

Soybean Market Commentary

The CBOT soybean market traded lower since yesterday with 1.39% and will open the day at \$12.23/bushel. The rest of the soy complex also shifted into the red. March soymeal and soy oil futures each shifted around 1.5% lower. Soybean export sales only reached 560 639 tons, trending 74% lower week-over-week, and eroding 54% below the prior four-week average. Analysts were expecting a bigger haul, offering trade guesses that ranged between 699 438 and 1.24 million tons. Soybean export shipments eased 3% below the prior four-week average, with 1.1 million tons. China, Mexico, Spain, Portugal, and Japan were the top five destinations. Local: The local soybean market experienced an increasing trading day. The cash market traded 1.7% higher opening today on R8 610/ton, the Mei'24 contract traded 1.4% higher opening today on R8 445/ton and the Jul'24 contract traded 1.4% higher opening today on R8 609/ton.

Wheat Market Commentary

The CBOT Wheat market traded higher since vesterday and will open the day at \$6.12/bushel. Wheat exports found 511 651 tons in combined old and new crop sales last week. Old crop sales were down 36% week-over-week but still 45% better than the prior four-week average. Total sales were toward the higher end of analyst estimates, which ranged between 198 673 tons and 669 438 tons. Wheat export shipments were up 32% week-over-week but still 11% below the prior four-week average, with 323 864 tons. China, Mexico, Indonesia, Japan, and the Dominican Republic were the top five destinations.

Local: The local wheat market experienced a mixed trading day. The cash price traded lower with 0.36% and will open the day at R6 160/ton, Mar'24 contract traded 0.08% higher and opening the day on R6 210/ton and the May'24 contract traded 0.08% higher and opening the day on R6 255/ton.
