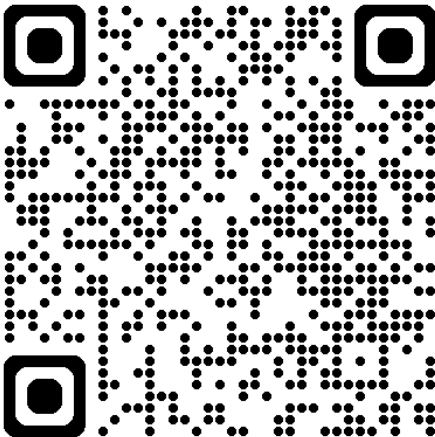

White maize:

- ❑ In week 19 of the 2026/27 marketing season, a total of **8,36 million tons** were delivered for the week ending 4th of September 2026, accounting for **94%** of the 7th CEC's adjusted production estimate of 9,5 million tons.
- ❑ This means that **593 456 tons** still need to be delivered over the remaining 33 weeks of the season, requiring average weekly deliveries of **17 984 tons**.
- ❑ Deliveries were **1,06 million tons** higher than the same period last season, and **1,52 million tons** above the 5-year average.
- ❑ Week-on-week deliveries decreased by **118 134 tons** from week 18.

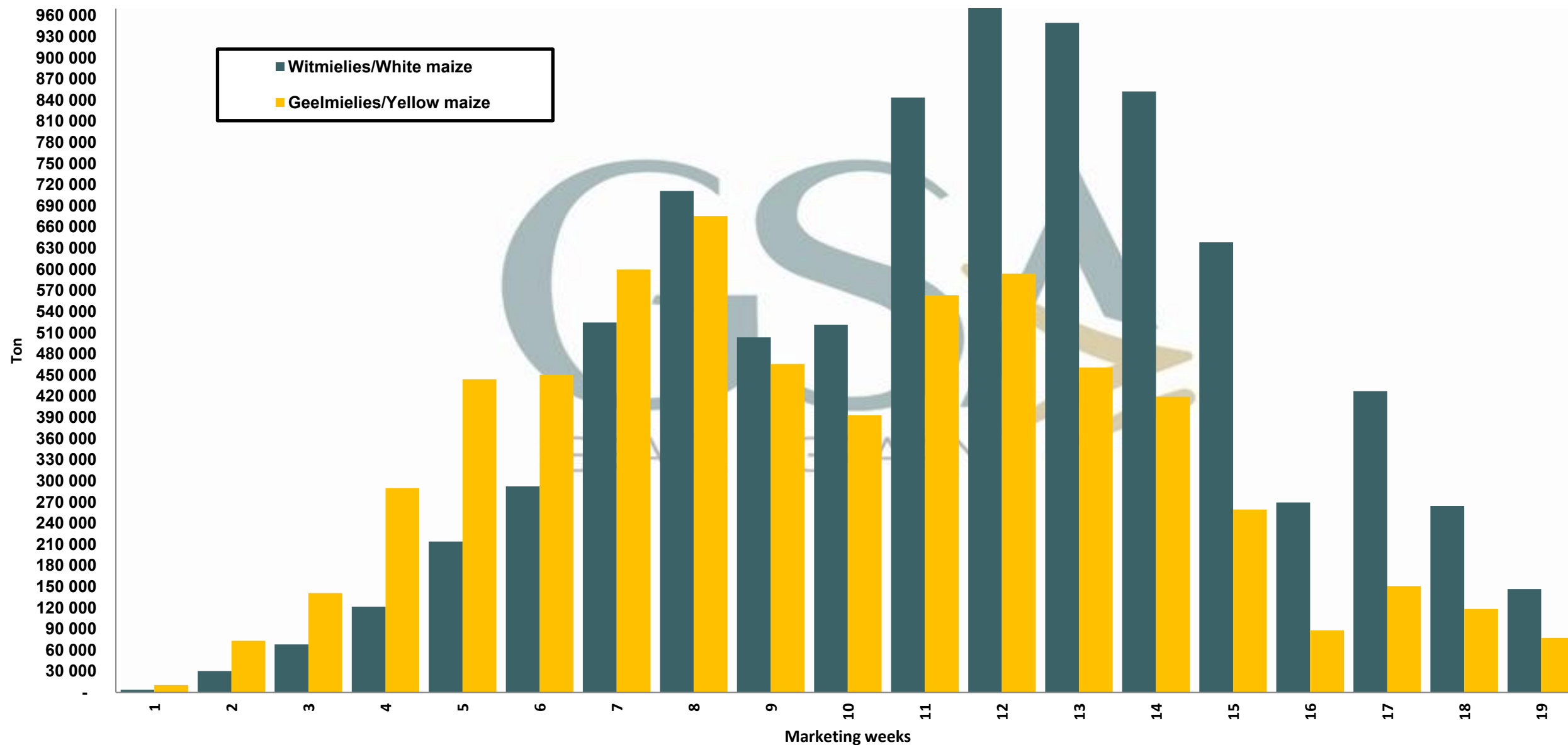
Yellow maize:

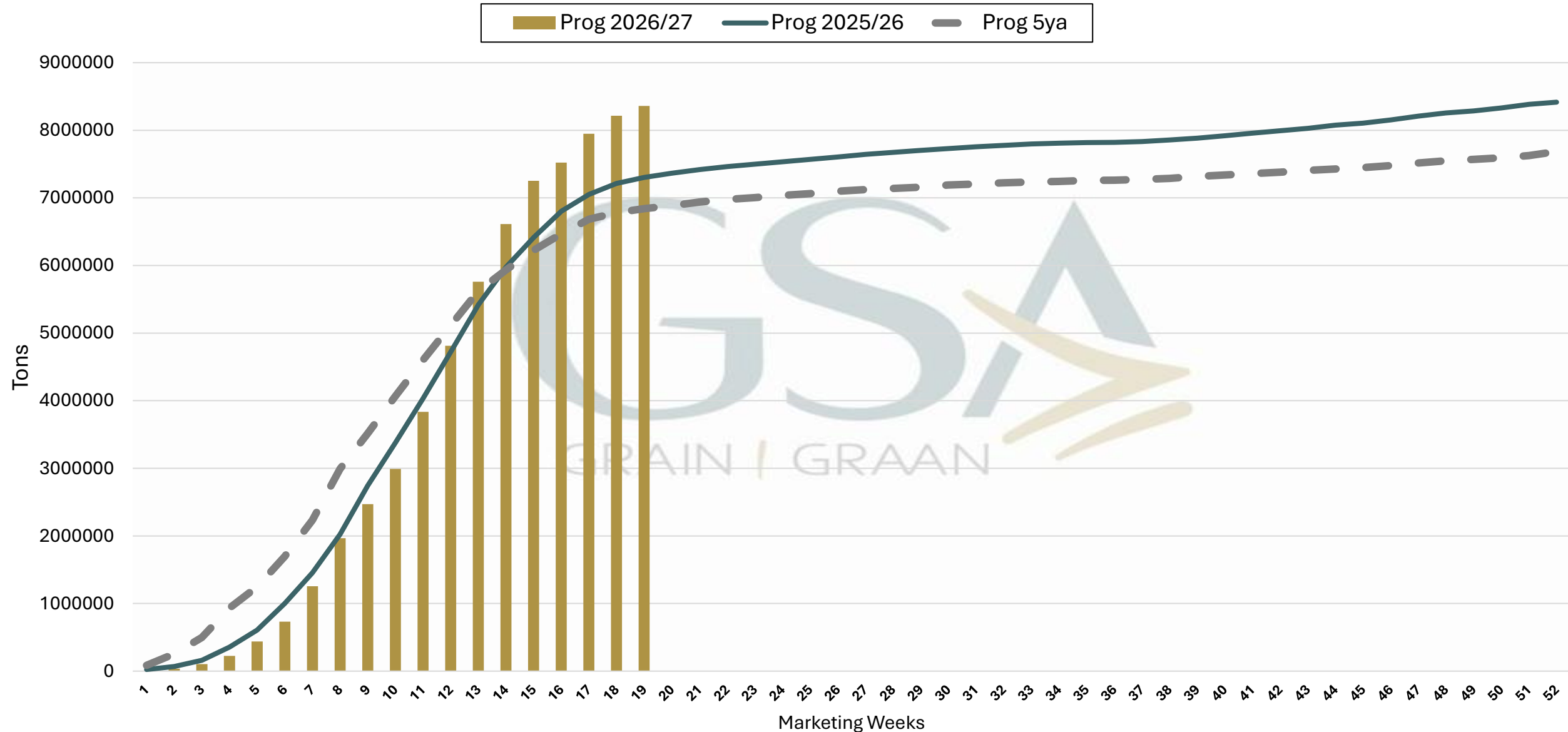
- ❑ In week 19 of the 2026/27 marketing season, a total of **6,28 million tons** were delivered for the week ending 4th of September 2026, representing **90%** of the 7th CEC's adjusted production estimate of 7,91 million tons.
- ❑ This leaves **774 448 tons** to be delivered over the remaining 33 weeks, requiring average weekly deliveries of **23 377 tons**.
- ❑ Deliveries were **371 422 tons** lower than the same period last season, and **113 153 tons** above the 5-year average.
- ❑ Week-on-week deliveries increased by **41 265 tons** from week 18.

The Crop Estimates Committee has forecast more white maize production this season, and this trend can be seen in the white maize deliveries, which have exceeded the volumes of yellow maize delivered since week 8 and are currently above the 5-year average and the deliveries made during the same time last season.

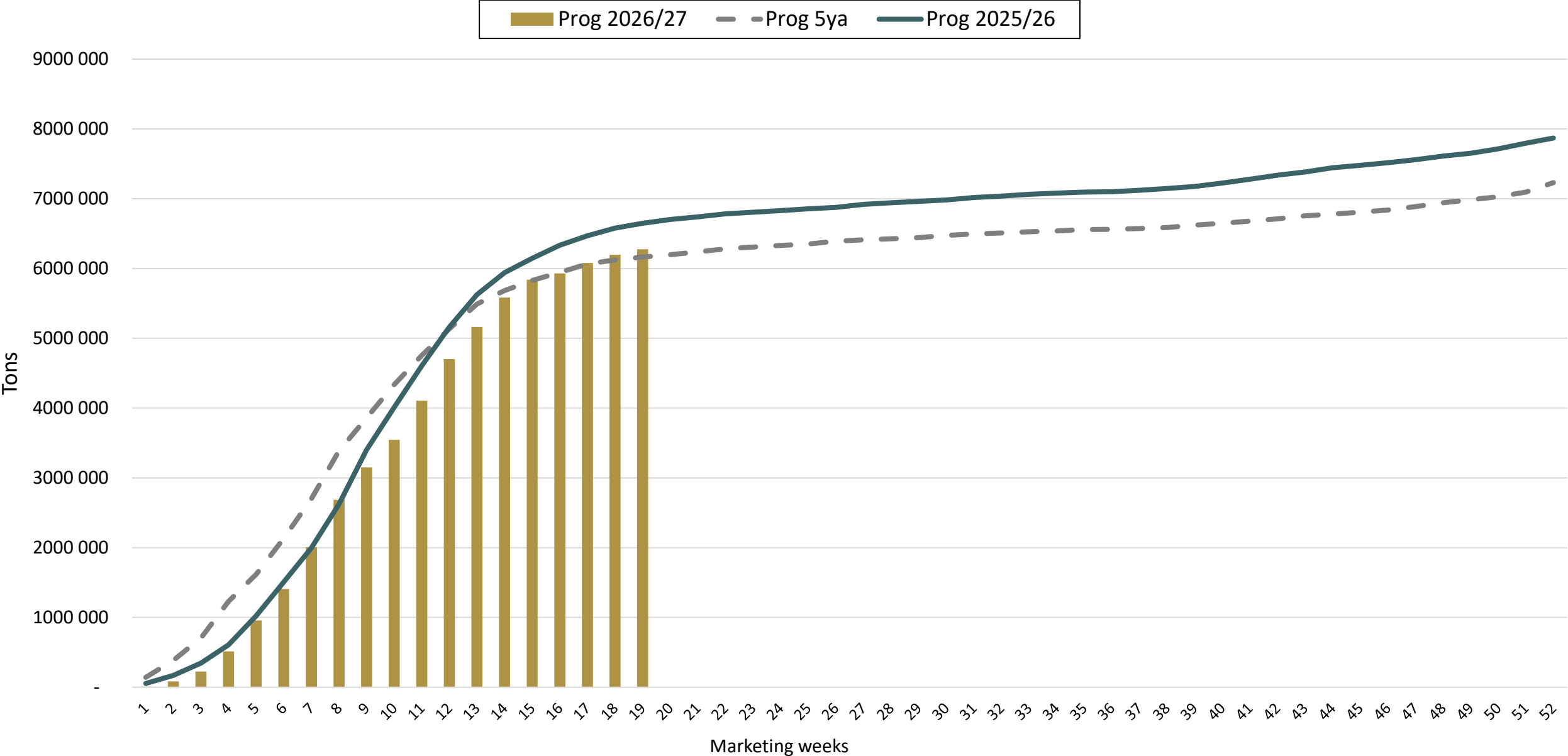

WEEKLY MAIZE DELIVERIES (2026/27 MARKETING SEASON: 25 APRIL TO 21 AUGUST 2026)

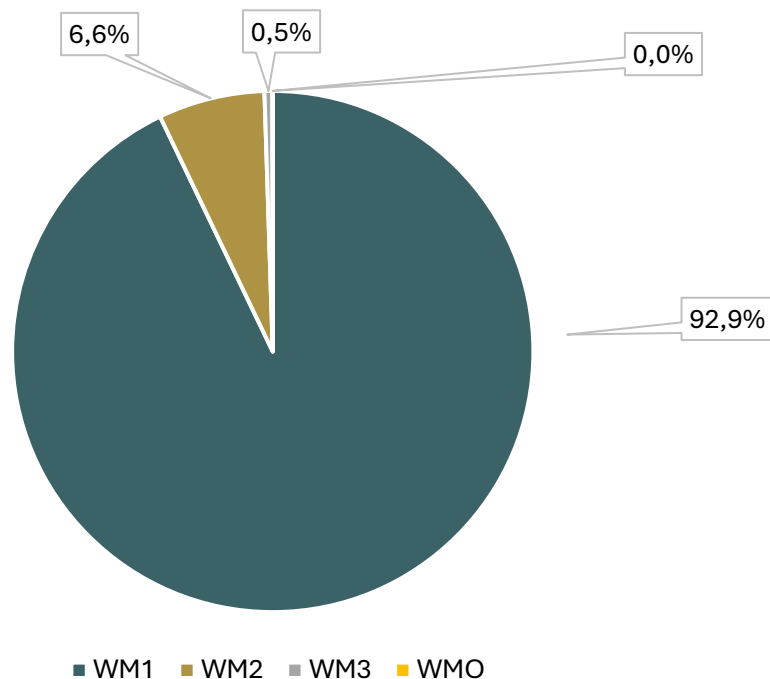




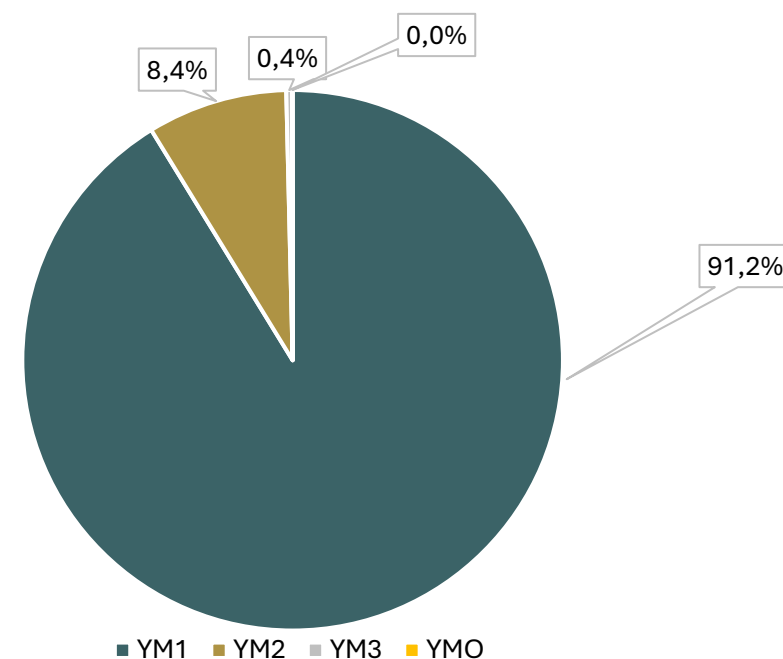
YELLOW MAIZE DELIVERIES TRENDS

- ❑ Between the 25th of April and the 4th of September 2026, producer deliveries amounted to **8,4 million tons of white maize** and **63 million tons of yellow maize**.
- ❑ Weekly grading information shows that the majority of deliveries met high-quality grade, with **7,8 million tons of WM1** and **5,7 million tons of YM1**.
 - ❖ For white maize, 92.9% was classified as Grade 1 (from 93% in week 18), with a further 6.6% in Grade 2.
 - ❖ Similarly, yellow maize was classified as 91.2% Grade 1 (remaining the same at 91,2% in week 18) and now 8,4% Grade 2.

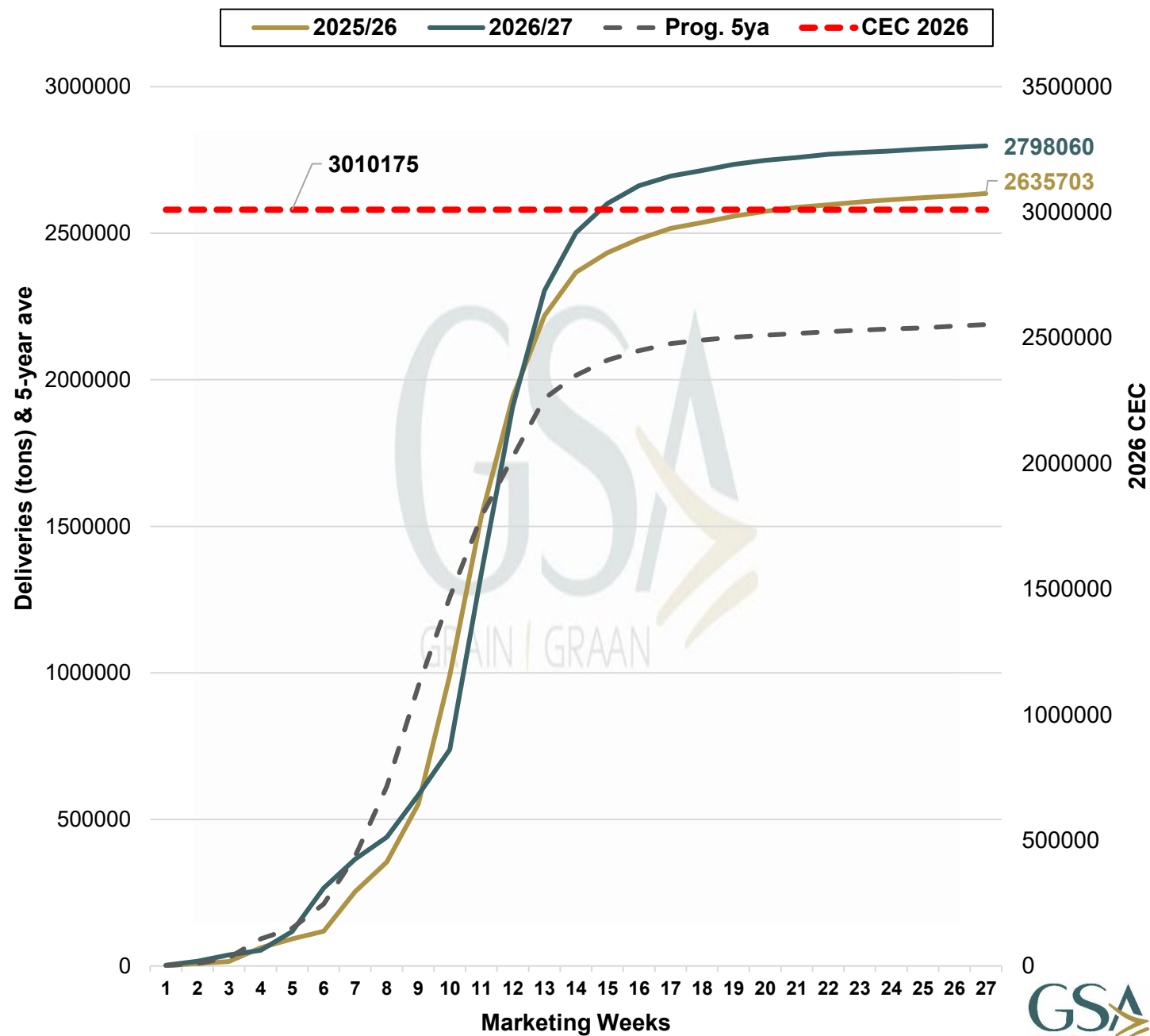

- ❑ As of week 27 of the 2026/27 marketing season, soybean deliveries have reached **2,8 million tons**, representing **94%** of the adjusted 7th CEC production estimate of **3,01 million tons**.
- ❑ This adjusted estimate accounts for seed retention of **45 000 tons**, with no additional volumes allocated to on-farm consumption or storage.
- ❑ However, to meet the full adjusted CEC estimate, a remaining **167 115 tons** must still be delivered over the next 25 weeks.
- ❑ This implies a required average weekly delivery rate of approximately **6 685 tons** for the remainder of the marketing season.

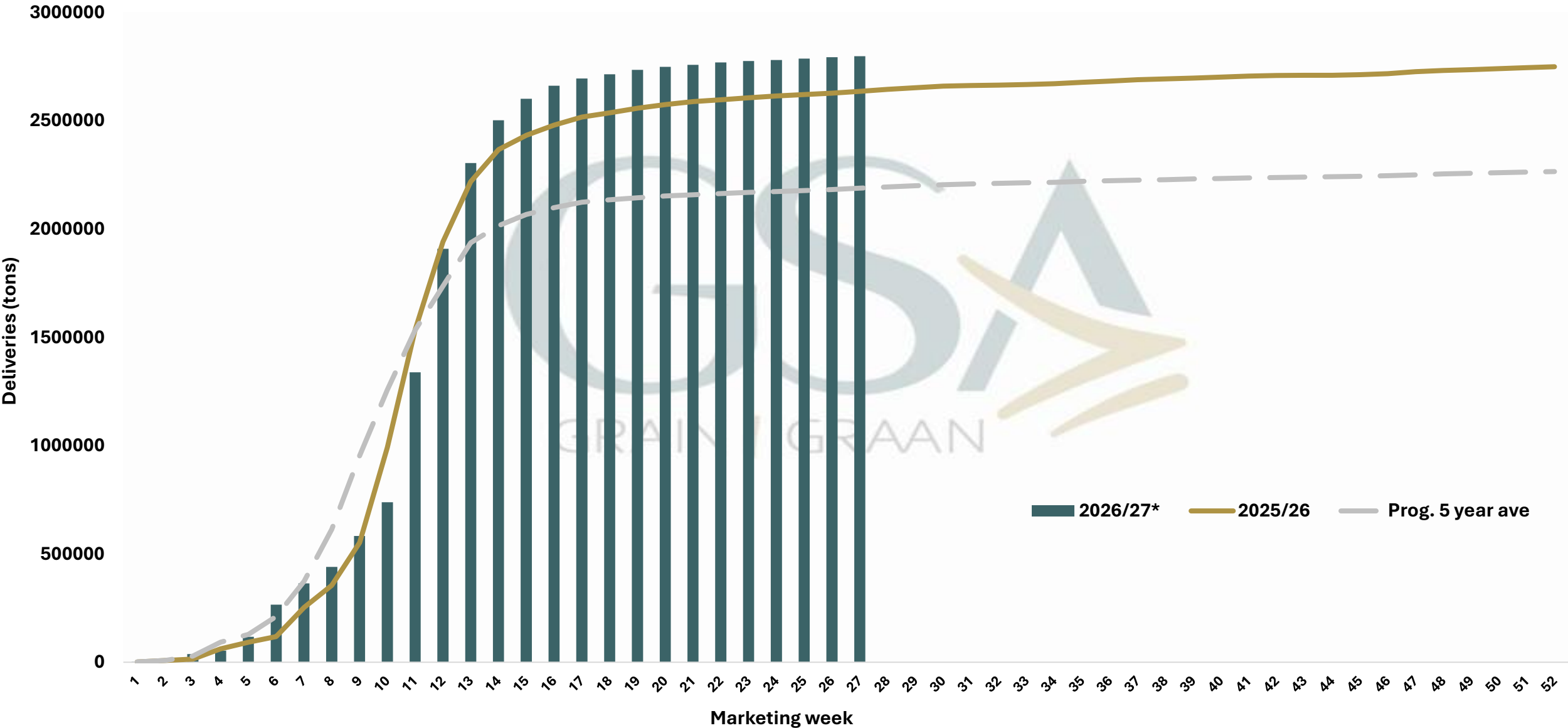
SOYBEANS

- By week 27 of the 2026/27 marketing season, cumulative commercial soybean deliveries have reached **2.8 million tons**, following **5 028 tons** of soybeans being delivered in the week ending 4th September 2026.
- Week-on-week deliveries increased from the previous week by **670 tons**.
- Weekly deliveries have decreased below **10 000 tons** from week 23, indicating that weekly deliveries are slowing down.
- Weekly producer deliveries are currently **609 491 tons** above the progressive five-year average and **162 357 tons** higher than the same period last season.

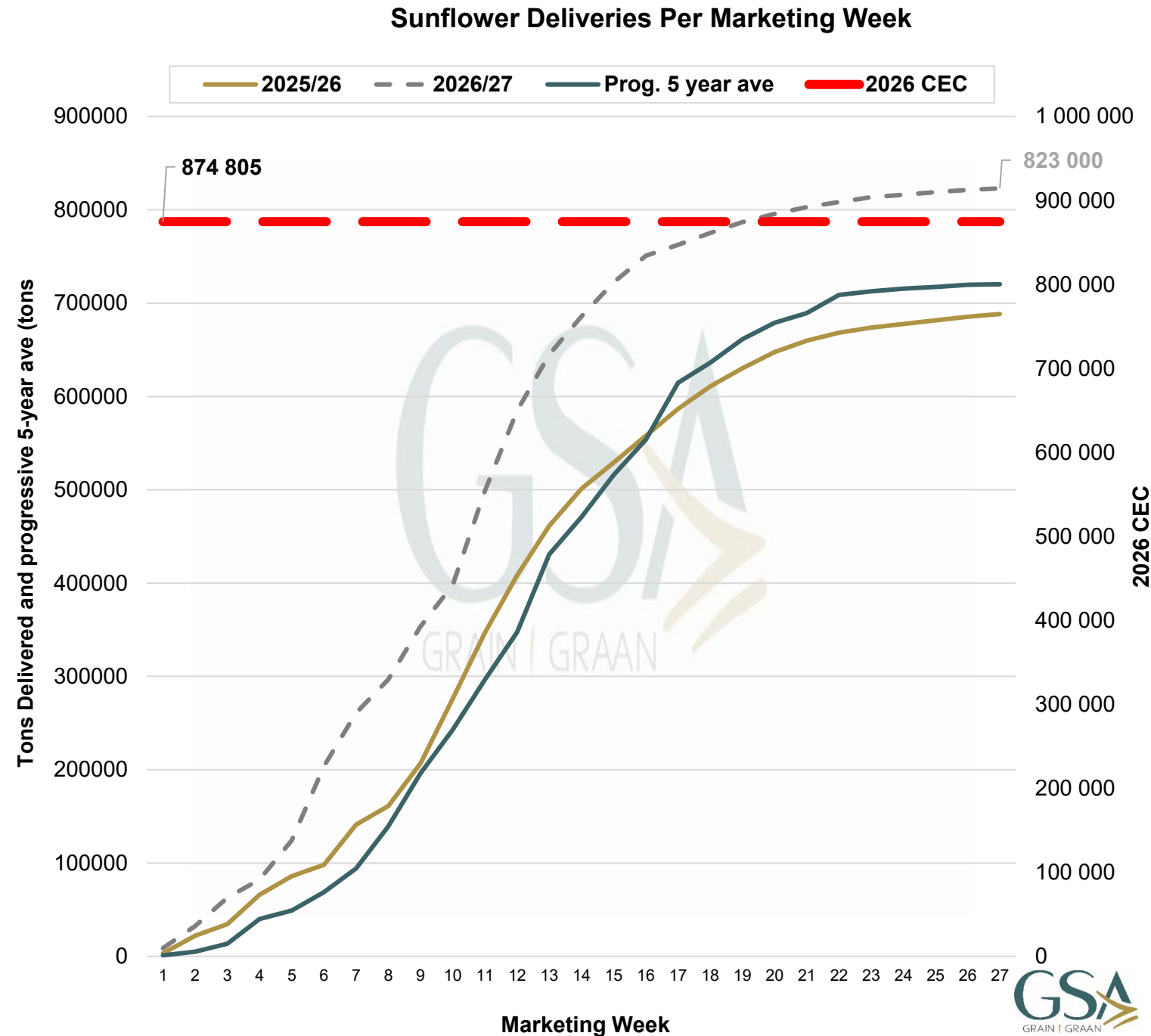

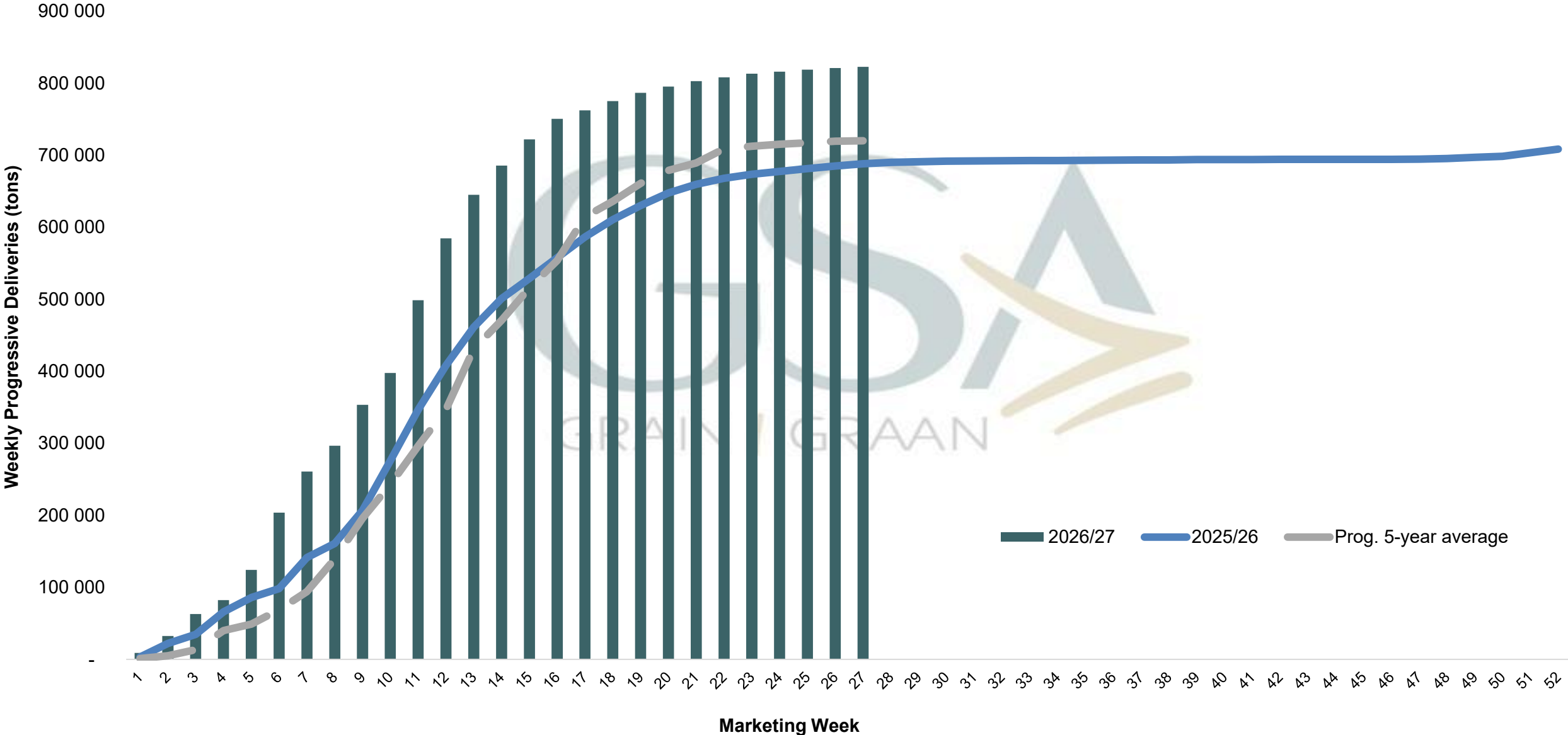
- As of week 27 of the 2026/27 marketing season, sunflower deliveries have reached **823 000 tons**, representing **94%** of the 7th CEC production estimate of **874 805 tons**.
- To meet the 7th 2026 CEC estimate, a remaining **51 805 tons** must still be delivered over the next **25 weeks**.
- This implies a required average weekly delivery rate of approximately **2 072 tons** for the remainder of the marketing season.

Sunflowers

- By week 27 of the 2026/27 marketing season, a total of **823 000 tons** have been delivered, after **1 664 tons** were delivered in the week ending 4th of September 2026.
- Week-on-week deliveries decreased by **571 tons** from **week 26**.
- Overall, sunflower deliveries this season are **102 753 tons** ahead of the *progressive five-year average* and **150 751 tons** ahead of the *progressive 3-year average*.
- The current total deliveries are **134 687 tons** higher than the deliveries made in the same period during the **2025/26 season**, indicating a strong early-season delivery pace.
